Schedule 3 has a currently accepted medical use in treatment in the Philippines; has a potential for abuse less than the drug in schedules 1 and 2 that may lead to moderate or low physical dependence or high psychological dependence.	-	Schedule III	-	- LEVEL 3
Schedule 4 has a currently accepted medical use in treatment in the Philippines; has a low potential for abuse less than the drug in schedule 3 that may lead to limited physical dependence or psychological dependence.	Schedule III	Schedule IV	-	- LEVEL 4
