Pasco County's recycling program has come a long way. Our Choose and Use Your Own Container program lets you recycle without costly blue bags; just give Pasco County Recycling or your trash hauler a call to get a sticker mailed out to you, or stop by your clubhouse to pick one up. You can put the sticker on any can, bin, or cart you like. You don't have to sort recyclables, since everything can go in one container. You've already paid for the service if you have curbside trash pickup, so why not take advantage of this valuable community service? Small changes in habit can make a big impact on our country and on the world. After all, we are borrowing the Earth from our children and grandchildren, and every soda can you recycle today helps make for a better tomorrow.

Mailbox and Post Information

This is a reminder to all residents to:

- **Clean and maintain your white mailbox.** Clean mold and dirt off your mailbox and post with a mixture of 2 - 4 ounces of bleach, ½ ounce of dish soap and 1 gallon warm water. Use a rag and scrub brush to clean off all the grime. If your box is too far gone, white (only) mailboxes can be purchased at home centers.
- **Paint, and maintain your mailbox post.** If your post needs more than just cleaning, you can purchase the 2 approved paint colors at the CDD office. Bring proof of Meadow Pointe I residency and \$10.
- **Replace missing house numbers on your mailbox post.**
