<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the direction of a Deputy Attorney General 1 or 2, or other supervisory attorney, represents the Division of Gaming Enforcement as prescribed by applicable statues; conducts work related to the investigation of casino operation matters, prosecution of regulatory violations, licensing of service industry entities and individuals, as well as provides legal advice for the Division's Technical Service Bureau on a wide range of issues; conducts legal research; does other related work and special assignments as required by the Deputy Director and Director; as the Attorney General's representative, participates in legal and related activities involving regulatory matters before the Director, Casino Control Commission, or any State courts as necessary. All of the above would correspond to the regulation of land-based casinos, internet gaming, and sports wagering.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

**EDUCATION**: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an attorney-at-law in the State of New Jersey required.

**EXPERIENCE**: Two (2) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

**LICENSE**: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.
