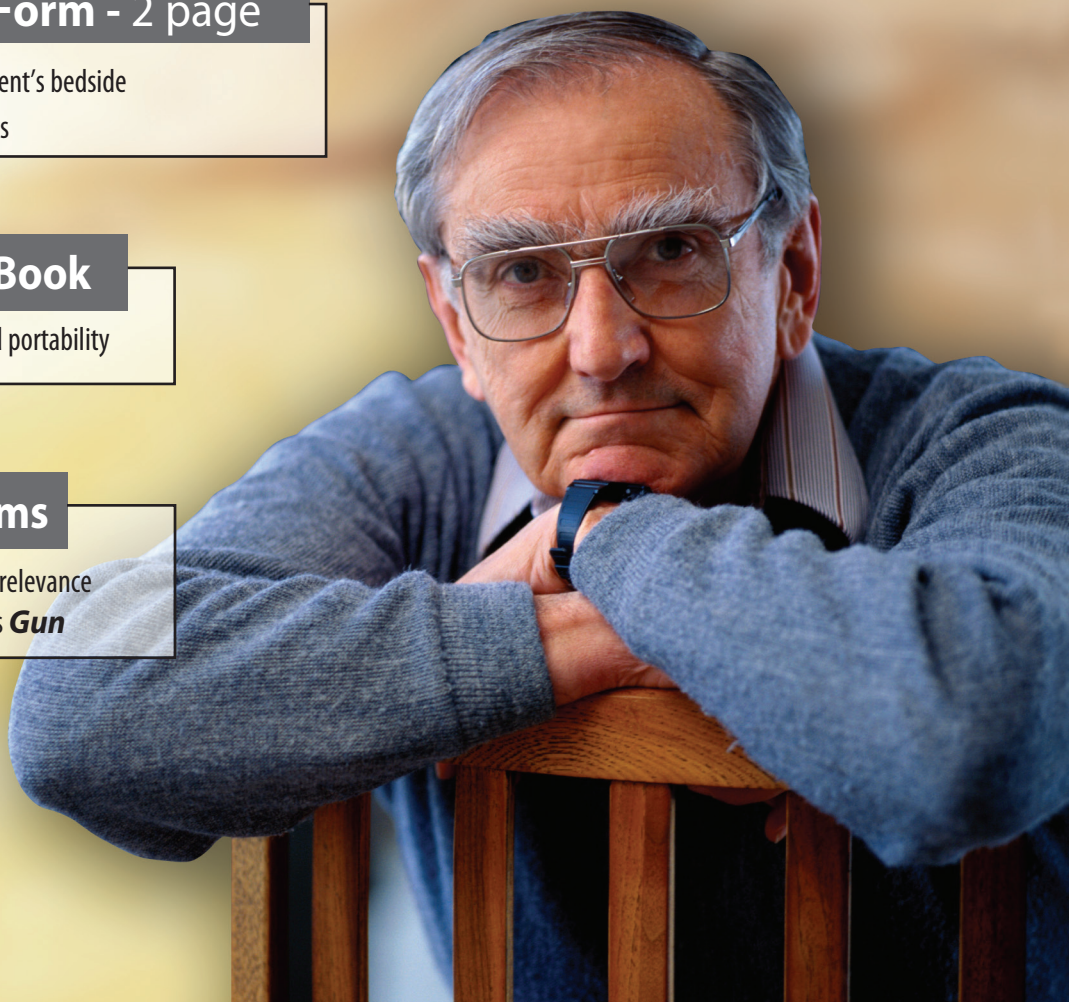

What does the WAB-R provide?

- Identifies and classifies types of aphasia
- Assesses linguistic skills most frequently affected by aphasia
 - Assesses nonlinguistic skills

Why is WAB-R used?

- Classifies the type and severity of aphasia disorder (if present) — and gives a clinically valid baseline for diagnosis, prognosis and research
- Bedside Record Form provides quick assessment for clinicians with time constraints, and busy schedules
 - Provides a baseline level of performance to measure change over time
- Adaptable to various administration settings from hospital room to clinic

When is the WAB-R best used?

- For initial assessment of patients with stroke
- For adults with acquired neurological disorders or disorders secondary to cerebral vascular accidents (strokes), head injury or dementia
 - For adults at a low to mid-range language functioning level or low SES level

Where is WAB-R used?

- Private practice
- Acute care hospitals and rehabilitation facilities
- Residential and non-residential adult treatment centers
 - Nursing homes
 - Skilled nursing facilities
- Private and university clinics
- Research settings for special studies
