

Quick Guide: Workforce ESP Self Service at Home (IE)

This guide will help you sign into Workforce ESP Self Service (Self Service) from **outside the Alberta Health Services (AHS) network** using a personal computer.



Refer to **QuickGuide: Workforce Self Service at Home (Safari)** if you are trying to access Self Service from an Apple computer.

Launch Internet Explorer

- 1. Find the Internet Explorer icon on your computer or start menu
- 2. Double click the icon



You must use Internet Explorer version 8 or higher to access Self Service.

Open the Alberta Health Services Home Page

Launching Internet Explorer will open a browser window.

- 1. Type <u>www.albertahealthservices.ca</u> in your browser bar
- 2. Press Enter

Workforce ESP (Environment for Scheduling Personnel) – Self Service is Alberta Health Services' remote electronic staff scheduling technology. Workforce ESP – Self Service was formerly known as R-ESP and ESP Self Service. Select your zone to log into Workforce ESP – Self Service
